McGill University Trust United Kingdom Residuary Gift Wording

- The Executors¹ shall hold the Trust Fund upon trust for McGill University Trust (registered charity number 1044904) (the **'Selected Charity'**) and I request the Selected Charity, but without imposing any binding trust or legal obligation, to use the Trust Fund for its general charitable purposes².
- Subject to the provisions of s311 of the Charities Act 2011, if at the date of my death the Selected Charity is no longer in existence or is subject to a winding-up order, the Executors shall hold the Trust Fund upon trust for McGill University, a public university located at 845 Sherbrooke St W, Montreal, Quebec H3A 0G4, Canada.
- The receipt of any trustee for the time being of the Selected Charity, or of any substituted charity to which the legacy is paid, shall be a full discharge to the Executors.

'The 'Trust Fund' shall mean:
